

Brian Marshall Obituary 24 May 2013

We are deeply saddened to report the death of Brian Marshall at the age of 67, a stalwart of the Humberside athletics scene for many years.

Brian started his career as an athlete with Riddings AC (later to become Scunthorpe & DAC following a merger with Scunthorpe Harriers), eventually becoming Secretary & Chairman of both Riddings AC and Scunthorpe DAC following its formation.

Brian also served as Humberside AA Treasurer and as a Track Referee for many years at all levels of the sport alongside his wife Ann and son's Steve and Neil who also became deeply involved with the sport.

His proudest achievement as an athlete was finishing the London Marathon in 2:43.48.

Brian will be a great loss to athletics in Scunthorpe and although he was no longer active across the North he will be greatly missed by many in the sport who will remember him as a knowledgeable, loyal and kind man who was a talented official and administrator and who loved the sport.
