This year his time of 14.39 was enough to give him the Northern Athletics 5k gold medal, but James Walsh was given the same time but placed behind Ben for the Silver medal, It was that close. Just 20 second behind them was Altrincham's Andy Norman for the bronze

medal.

The team results were also very close. .Blackburn won the team gold with 35 points, Sale 2nd with 46, and Salford 3rd 67 points, just 1 point ahead of Stockport 4th.
