	U13 Boys & Girls	Competitors who have reached their 11 th birthday but not their 13 th birthday by midnight 31 st August 2021

All athletes competing in the Yorkshire Championships MUST have been born in NORTH, SOUTH OR WEST YORKSHIRE or have nine months continuous residence in the counties prior to the competition. Birth Certificates must be produced on request. You cannot compete in the championships of more than one county in a 12-month period.

THERE ARE NO MINIMUM STANDARDS REQUIRED TO ENTER THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

All athletes must be registered with England Athletics, and all entry forms and online entries must be completed in full with England Athletics registration numbers.

Athletes must retain their vest numbers but must report to registration again if they are competing on the following day.

Please note in accordance with UKA Rule 21

(6) Additional Rules & Conditions: Any Competition Provider may apply additional rules and conditions to those required in UKA rules but must not relax any Rules.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR 2021

Although we hope all current Covid restrictions will be lifted on July 19th 2021, this championship and all events listed will be subject to any Covid guidelines or rules in place on Saturday and Sunday 21st and 22nd August 2021.

Holding the Yorkshire Track and Field Championships so late in the year and during a pandemic is all unknown territory to us. We have no idea what to expect with numbers of entries or any additional rules that may be in place at the time. As such, anything listed on the prospectus could be subject to change or cancellation at short notice. While we will endeavour to ensure that this doesn't happen, we ask you to understand that any decisions made regarding the championships will be made solely with the safety of athletes, officials, and spectators being the priority. Refunds will be issued only if any decisions of this nature are made by Yorkshire County Athletics Association. We will keep you informed as much as possible.... It is not usual practise in athletics to issue a refund if an athlete becomes injured, ill or double booked and that will remain the case.
